

# I-65 to Destin

**This is by far the quickest and easiest route, but lots of turns.**

Continue to take I 65 south in Alabama. 50-60 miles south of Montgomery take Exit 114.

This is highway 106, go east (over the expressway) for about 1.5 miles to **US 55, STAY on US55**. Stay on this road for a total of 25 miles until you reach US84 (1<sup>st</sup> stop sign).

Turn left on 84/55 to Andalusia, about 4 miles to US29/55 south.

Turn right on US29/55, go 11 miles to Hwy 137 south, (left is the only way you can go) (also Blue Lake sign).

You go about 32 miles south, the road starts as 137, turns into 189, then turns into Hwy 4. Stay straight on this road till it dead ends into US90, (stop sign).

Turn left, go 1 mile to Hwy 4, (there is a light, turn right (south). *This is a bypass of Crestview. If missed, you can go into Crestview and catch 85 south.*

*When you are going back north this street is the second light as you are coming into Crestview (Tom Thumb station on this corner).*

Take Hwy 4 just over 5 miles, to 85 (Stop light) turn right, toward Niceville.

11 miles after you turn onto 85 there is a fork in the road, and light, with 85 going into Ft Walton Beach and Niceville, take the right fork into FT Walton Beach.

Stay on 85 until it dead ends into US98 in downtown Ft Walton Beach.

Turn Left towards Destin, take US98 into Destin.

After crossing the bridge into Destin go 2 miles to Gulf Shore Dr. There is a Texaco station on the south east corner, (The only Texaco on 98). Turn right or towards the ocean.

About 500 feet on Gulf Shore turn left into drive along strip plaza, Look for Holiday Isle Properties sign, walk through breezeway to Office to get rental package. If you are arriving after hours contact Holiday Isle (800) 837-5102 for instructions on getting package.

There are 3 stop signs (not counting the stop light) on Gulf Shore. When you stop at the third stop sign you are in front of our security gate (Destin Pointe). Drive straight in and tell the guard you are renting 201 in Magnolia House.
